Celebrating 150 Years with Notes from Our Past



Many in our congregation have visited or worshiped at National City Christian Church in Washington, D.C. The neoclassical building designed by architect John Russell Pope (who also designed the Jefferson Memorial, the National Art Gallery, and the National Archives) is considered the national cathedral for Disciples of Christ. But did you know that the Rev. Dr. Harvey Harmon, one of the most prominent pastors at First Christian, was instrumental in its construction and served as the first pastor after it was built? Here's an article from the August 9, 1929 edition of **The Church at Work**:

"The contract for the erection of the National City Christian Church at Washington, D.C. has been let to the George A. Fuller Construction Company of New York, the building to be completed by September 1, 1930, in time for the proposed World Convention in Washington in October of that year. A campaign under the direction of Dr. H.H. Harmon has been under way to raise \$1,750,000, and while the full amount is not yet in hand, a sufficient amount has been obtained to warrant proceeding with the plans."
