We have a new baby! On January 3, our Afghan refugee family increased by one when mom, Razia, delivered a 7lb 15 oz baby boy. Baby Arian and mom went home on Jan. 4 and our Disciple resettlement team will keep in close touch, helping where needed when dad, Ghaousudin, returns to work next week. The DOC churches involved in this resettlement divided up a list of needed items and "showered" our family with baby gear; in addition, clothing and toys were gifted to the older children as they are continuing to grow. Keep this family in your prayers as Razia recovers and Arian joins his older sister and two older brothers in the family.




Book Club News
