Go and Do the Same Luke 10:37

These lyrics from Leeland's worship song "Follow You" encourage us to give. To give of ourselves to God, ALL of our selves.

There are many ways that we can give, especially as we prepare to enter the time of Lent. As we begin our journey through a season of wilderness, we can be together each week, and worship will help enhance that journey and center us.

We'll start by gathering together on Ash Wednesday and leave our worship with ashes on our foreheads. We'll continue through Lent by worshiping each week and pondering music from our ensembles, and lyrics from the hymns and worship songs we sing. As we journey closer to Easter, we'll gather together during special services on Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. We will draw closer to God and look forward to the glorious celebration of Jesus' resurrection on Easter Sunday.
