Sermon

From The Rev. Kara Hillhouse "Baaa"

I haven't spent much time around sheep (although I did spend one particularly cold March night helping a woman milk 200 goats, which was interesting.). In the Bible, sheep are mentioned a lot. A lot. 577 times, if you count all the times sheep, rams and lambs are mentioned (in the New International Version of the Bible)—more than any other animal. Sheep were indicators of wealth, objects to be sacrificed, and, in the New Testament, a metaphor for followers of Christ. Our text this weekend is on the sheep, sheepfold and shepherd, and the significance of following the Good Shepherd, not the thief that comes to steal. We hope you'll join us for worship, either online or in-person!

Scripture Reading

Psalm 23

John 10:1-10

A Psalm of David. The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.

He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside still waters;

he restores my soul. He leads me in right paths for his name's sake.

Even though I walk through the darkest valley,

I fear no evil; for you are with me; your rod and your staff they comfort me.

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me

all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord my whole life long. Very truly, I tell you, anyone who does not enter the sheepfold by the gate but climbs in by another way is a thief and a bandit. The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep hear his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice. They will not follow a stranger, but they will run from him because they do not know the voice of strangers.' Jesus used this figure of speech with them, but they did not understand what he was saying to them.

So again Jesus said to them, 'Very truly, I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and bandits; but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters by me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.
