

One: The Spirit, who breathes life into emptiness, gives all creation the gift of peace.


Many: Come to us and refresh us with the dew of delight.

If Children, Then Heirs

To be an heir was something very particular in the Apostle Paul's world. There would have been an elite status designated for the oldest male child, who would be the heir of his father's life's savings and work. But Paul makes the assertion that to be a child of God—any child of God, no matter your position in the family, no matter your position in society, no matter your worthiness or lack thereof — you are an heir. We are all heirs, and we have inherited God's love and redemption, not because we earned it but because we are loved. To be heirs of God's love and life is a game changer. Scripture Readings

Isaiah 6:1-8

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lofty; and the hem of his robe filled the temple. Seraphs were in attendance above him; each had six wings: with two they covered their faces, and with two they covered their feet, and with

The pivots on the thresholds shook at the voices of those who called, and the house filled with smoke. And I said, "Woe is me! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!"

Then one of the seraphs flew to me, holding a live coal that had been taken from the altar with a pair of tongs. The seraph touched my mouth with it and said: "Now that this has touched your lips, your guilt has departed and your sin is blotted out." Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I; send me!"

Romans 8:12-17

So then, brothers and sisters, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh - for if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a spirit of adoption. When we cry, "Abba! Father!" it is that very Spirit bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ - if, we in fact suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him.
