Pastor's Corner

Dear Friends,

"The place God calls you to is the place where your deep gladness and the world's deep hunger meet." ---Frederick Buechner

God is actively pursuing the redemption of His creation. He wants to bring us healing. And the really cool thing is that He does it, in part, through *you and me*. It would be arrogant of us to assume we are the *only* means through which He works, but we are certainly an important part of the equation. When God works in our lives, He invites us (never forces us) to go in directions that will be good for us and His Kingdom. And that inevitably means we arrive in places that might seem a little uncomfortable, places we'd rather not be. But perhaps it is at that exact location that someone is waiting for us. Waiting for our smile, our support, our encouragement. Waiting for our guidance and wisdom. Or, perhaps we arrive at an intersection where we are the one in need of smiles, support, encouragement, guidance and wisdom, and someone else is waiting to help us. We may never understand why we are taken to certain places in our lives; but if we can *trust* that God is good - *always* - then maybe we can be willing to sit awhile in discomfort and wait for God to work.

Now I am *not* saying that God has called you to places like cancer, seizures, depression, divorce, unemployment, loneliness, and grief. I don't believe God causes these things, or wants these things for us. What I do believe is that He works *through* them to bring good; he redeems them *somehow*. If you are in one of those scary places hold on, because I believe God will cause you to intersect in ways and places that will allow Him to redeem whatever you are going through. Look for the intersections in your life. The place where your life comes together with someone else's in significant ways. These are the places God has invited you to go. And, if you are there, you have accepted God's invitation. Congratulations! It takes courage to go somewhere unknown. But that is the life of faith, being willing to go where we cannot see, trusting that God is already there waiting for us. May your life be filled with meaningful, life-changing intersections. We'll see you in church!

Communications Team - January Board Report

I want to give a big Thank You to everyone who supports FCC's YouTube and social media platforms and shares the great work happening at FCC.

In 2024, our YouTube Channel saw an increase of an additional 100 subscribers. We now have 239 subscribers. Our channel now has had 42,720 views in 2024 compared to 19,151 views in 2023 which is a 123% increase. 93.5% of our views are from non-subscribers. We continue to have viewers from around the world. Our top five videos to date are 1) The Lord is God with 1,674 views; 2) Glorious Things of Thee are Spoken with 1,020 views; 3. Joyful, Joyful We Adore Thee with 964 views; 4) Praise Ye the Lord with 906 views; and 5) Lord Who Throughout These Forty Days with 871 views. THANK YOU to our Video Team for streaming our services every week. This wouldn't be possible without YOU! We now have an average of 50 to 60 views of our weekly worship service each week.

We also have seen some growth in our Facebook and Instagram pages. We now have 325 Facebook followers and 111 Instagram followers compared with 292 Facebook and 107 Instagram followers in 2023. Our Facebook and Instagram pages are also followed around the world. We have had 23.7K Facebook views and 1,400 Instagram views in 2024.

If you haven't checked out our YouTube videos already, I encourage you to do so. I would also encourage you to Subscribe to our channel and click the Like button on our videos. Also, if there is a video you really enjoy, share it with your friends. The number of subscribers and likes play a role in the algorithm that suggests our videos to viewers.

If you have a Facebook or Instagram page, I would encourage you to Follow First Christian Church and to like our posts. This also helps these algorithm's to help people find our pages. If you don't have a Facebook or Instagram page, it is free to sign up. Shhh, you don't have to follow your friends or other pages, just follow First Christian Church so you don't miss out. The posts with pictures showing the life and activities of our church consistently have the best reach of our posts. If you are involved in a church activity, take some pictures and send them to me, so I can post them. If there is a post you really like, share it with your Facebook or Instagram friends and introduce them to what we have to share about First Christian Church.

I continue to be amazed at how far the ministry of First Christian Church has spread around the world. We can grow it even bigger with your help!


